The ATACC course was initially conceived as a anaesthetically biased, UK relevant trauma course.

Over the years the three day course has evolved and now attracts participants from Emergency Medicine, Surgery, Critical Care as well as Nurses and Paramedics.

The course is ideal for those practicing in the pre-hospital arena as well as those in areas immediately receiving trauma patients.

The course is a practical one with short, punchy lectures followed by hands on skills stations and scenarios.

The ATACC faculty draws on various Medical specialties as well as paramedical and fire service instructors ensuring the course is up to date and reflects current evidence based practice in trauma management.

Topics covered include:-

Safety, Kinematics, Primary Survey, Massive Haemorrhage, Airway Management, Thoracic Trauma, Shock and Coagulopathy, Radiology, Neuro. Trauma, Damage Control Surgery, Orthopaedic Injury, Disaster Management, Special Trauma Circumstances, Critical Care Transfer
